

Why become sad? Why become distressed? Why complain? You are eternal. Nobody can ever cause harm to you. You are That! So who could cause any harm to Me?

Active devotees thwarted the conspiracy

Chanting (Kirtana) was performed behind closed doors in the house of Shirvās Pandit, a disciple of Chaitanya Mahāprabhu. Some people, filled with jealousy and hatred, would visit there and return, censoring the chanting of the divine name upon seeing the closed doors. One of them was Gopāl Chāpāl.

He plotted a conspiracy to defame the devotees of God.

One night, while chanting of the divine name was being performed in the house, Chāpāl went outside the house and smeared a small

area with mud and put all the material for worship of Chandi there. He also put meat and liquor in two separate vessels. The following day, when the devotees came out after doing kirtana of the divine name, they were surprised to see the material.


At the same time, a group of wicked slanderers arrived and started saying to each other: "We already know that these people keep women and chant Hari nāma loudly with closed doors, and secretly do the worship of Bhairavi inside, using the method of Vāma-Marga (the left-handed way of Tantra). See with your own eyes the material for worship of Chandi here."

The devotees threw away the offensive material and smeared the area with desi cow dung and then sanctified it by

sprinkling it with Gangā water.

The people of contemporary society were very vigilant, intelligent, and organised. They understood that that was the deed of a deceitful man. It was known to them that the conspiracy and vicious propaganda carried out by wicked people against devotees and

> virtuous people would keep increasing if borne silently, which causes great harm to society itself. Therefore it is important that good people remain alert and active to maintain unity



and raise their voices in support of the truth. They held a meeting and exchanged ideas and proclaimed by beating a drum (to announce publicly) that if this happened again, the concerned wicked person would be taken to task.

Chāpāl cringed in fear. He thought that it was good that he was saved, otherwise he would have been in a sorry state. The thought of repeating it never again came into his mind again.

Instead of defaming Shrivas Pandit, this incident increased his fame and boosted the morale of virtuous men and destroyed the morale of the wicked. But Bhakta Shrivas Pandit was not at all influenced by this. He would remain engrossed in chanting of the divine name, divine knowledge, divine joy, and divine reflection.

Hanumān Ji's birthday falls on Chaitra Pūrņimā. There was an art to transforming Karma into Yoga in the life of Hanumān

Ji. Even if you practice a small amount of this art in your life, your life will be endowed with the realisation of unblemished Nārāvana (God). Hanumān Ji knows the importance of selfless service. False servants seek authority, increase desires, and destroy their lives in sense enjoyment. True servants, without seeking authority, serve the person in

front of them in such a way that

it makes their body healthy, mind cheerful, and intelligence illuminated with the light of the bestower of intelligence (God).

The extraordinary incarnation story

The story of Hanuman Ji is somewhat extraordinary. The Fire God appeared from Dasharath's sacrificial fire with a bowl of pāyasam (pudding) to bless him with sons.

VasishthaJi said: "O King! Your lawful wife is KausalyāJi, and Kaikeyi is your beloved."

So the king gave half of the pudding to KausalyāJi. The remaining half was divided into two parts and given to Kaikeyi and Sumitrā.

Noticing this, Kaikeyi became furious and said to DasharathJi, "What do you think of me? Why am I the last, and she was first to get it? Do you regard me as a maid?"

Due to this, Kaikeyi - Pujya Bapuji schemed. A kite sent cross by Lord Shiva snatched the bowl of pudding from

Kaikeyi's hand and flew it to mount Anjan where Anjanā Devi was performing a penance in order to bear a divine son. The kite flew to her and put the pudding in her hand. Anjanā Devi was in deep meditation. "The kite had placed the pudding," she had no idea. She believed that "as I was worshipping Lord Shiva, he gave me this prasād." So she ate the

prasād. Due to which she conceived, and

Hanumān Ji was born as her son.

Kind Kausalyā and Sumitrā both gave Kaikeyi some pudding after noticing how upset she was about the kite stealing her pudding.

Not ashamed of doing Rāma's work!

When Hanumān Ji couldn't be captured at Ashok Vātikā, Meghnāda launched the Brahmāstra. Hanumān Ji honoured the Brahmāstra, and fell down from the tree. Meghnāda saw that Hanumān Ji had swooned; he entangled him with a Nāgapāsha and carried him off. Entangled Hanumān Ji was made to stand in Rāvaṇa's assembly, but there was no sign of embarrassment or mischief on Hanumān Ji's face. Seeing Hanumān Ji's boldness, carefreeness, and equanimity, Rāvaṇa was enraged. He said, "Hey monkey! Nāgapāsha has brought you here bound, and you are standing carefree as if this

and instructions. Our good lies

in that alone. One should never disregard what they say.

Vasishtha Ji Mahārāj, in Shri Yoga Vashishtha

Mahārāmāyana, says:

"There is no one in the three worlds who can disobey

the great men, and having done that, enjoys happiness."

Bhagavān Shankara says:

गुरुणां सदसद्वापि यदुक्तं तन्न लंघयेत् । कुर्वन्नाज्ञां दिवारात्रौ दासवन्निवसेद् गुरौ ॥

"One should never disregard the Guru's words irrespective of their being true or false. He should live with the Guru, like a servant carrying out his commands day and night."

Even if the Guru's words appear to be false, the disciple should not doubt him and follow his instructions implicitly.

A great Guru-Bhakta disciple, Rāmu, lived in Saurashtra (Guj.). He would write letters to Lālaji Mahārāj. Lālaji Mahārāj narrated a life event about Rāmu.

One day, Rāmu's Guru said: "Rāmu! Hire a horse-drawn carriage. We have to go to a devotee's house to eat."

Rāmu brought a hired carriage. Guru was displeased with him. He said, "It is 7 a.m., and you fool, have got a carriage in the early morning? We are going to eat at around 11 to 12 o'clock, but you have got the cart! The poor coachman will have to wait for 4–5 hours."

Rāmu went and relieved the coachman.

Guru asked: "What did you do?"

Rāmu, with folded hands, said: "I returned the carriage."

Guru: "When we are supposed to go, why did you return it? Go, and bring it back."

Rāmu brought the carriage back. "Guruji! The cart has arrived."

Guruji: "Oh! What is this? You brought the carriage yet again? You know that we are leaving at noon, right? How much do I have to make you understand? If you can't understand this simple thing, how will

The carriage was sent back. Rāmu returned, and Guru shouted, "You sent him back again! Now, what if we don't get it in time? Go and get it back."

you understand God?"

The carriage was brought and returned nine times. Rāmu never said, "Guru Mahārāj! You had only said that..." That worthy disciple did not get irritated even for a moment. Guruji, however, was constantly creating situations to irritate him. But Rāmu did not know how to get annoyed with his Guruji; no matter what, he never frowned in front of his Guruji.

When the carriage was brought for the 10th time, it was finally accepted, and by that time, it was 12 o'clock. Rāmu and Guruji went to the devotee's house and ate. The devotee was wealthy. While the two parted, he offered some clothes at Guruji's holy feet and put ten 100 rupee notes tied in a handkerchief, and humbly prayed with folded hands: "Guruji! Please do not refuse; kindly accept at least this much." (1000

The illegal imprisonment of Asharamji Bapu, a great

man of dharma who has nurtured and propagated Sanatan dharma and performed the herculean task of leading

the masses from the darkness of ignorance to the light of knowledge, who did great work to bring the converted people back into Hindu Dharma, is an insult to our

nation and culture, and also a great misfortune for us. Those by whom this has been perpetrated are punishable without a doubt.

On the one hand, drug dealers, murderers and adulterers are arrested but get released on bail by making the court work in the middle of the night, and they sit in their homes peacefully. But, on the other hand, saint Asharamji Bapu, who carries the banner of dharma for the welfare of the nation and society, and protection of culture has been deceitfully imprisoned. I strongly condemn this act.

He was accused of wicked conduct but it hasn't been proven. There are several pieces of evidence along with the medical report which prove Bapuji's innocence. Subramanyan Swamy Ji also made this point very clear. Aged Bapuji has been kept in jail under a conspiracy. This is not only the imprisonment of Bapuji but the imprisonment of the culture and glory of our nation, and the
